There is a sign-up sheet in the back of the church in Portree for people to volunteer to drive Fr. Noel to Mass in Broadford and Dornie. It is worth reminding that if lots of people volunteer, each person does not have to do it very often. If only a few do so, their burden is greater.

The Feast of the Assumption might be a few weeks away, but the Masses are as usual: Vigil at 7pm in Portree, then 6pm in Dornie, and 7:30pm in Broadford on the feast itself. There is a Polish priest, Fr. Jarek Kwiecien, who has been here before, who is doing a course at Sabhal Mor Ostaig, and he will say the Masses in Dornie and Broadford. Fr Noel will take care of Mass in Portree.

I have managed to shift the pile of clothes for the refugees. It took a lot longer than usual because the depot in Conon Bridge has closed down. If you want to continue to give clothing to them, please do not bring them here. Instead the best option is to find "Sleatfugees" on Facebook and they can help you.
